*1906 1914-16	Reginald A. Fessenden, Canadian Physicist/Tech. Sent 1st TRANSALANTIC voice broadcast from Boston MASS. (pdf radiofath Meeting were held in charter members homes... called themselves ... " Old Timers " !? Also called the "wireless Nuts". 1st meeting was <u>Oct. 28, 1914</u>
*1916	approx (45) members HOOSIER SCOUT RADIO CLUB incorporates the OLD ! Hoosier Radio Club (Meeting 4 times a month!)
1916-1918	Members gathered places like * Old Madison Ave. Branch Library * The OLD Chamber of Commerce Building * Manual Boy's Club * Occasionally at some church ? (unknown)
*1918	1st Permanent Quarters in the old Chamber of Commerce Building
1920-1926	moved (4) times. & IRC, Owned & operated WBBI, Pioneer broadcasting station ! * Old Short ridge High School, N. Pennsylvania St. * YMCA * Chamber of Commerce Bldg. * back to the YMCA
*1922 1926	1st IRC sponsored Hoosier Hamfest was (see 1932 Pdf file) April 5, Old Naval Reserve Armory, E. North St.
*	1st Amateur Radio call obtained and operated W9JP -was Donald M. Davis; c w only spark Xmtr. (see 1940 Hamfest pdf page 1)
1928	Merchants Power & Light Company or " Daylight Corner "& Century Building, S. Pennsylvania St. (QRA) then same as QTH !
***1928	1st IRC sponsored ; IN Central Division convention held at the Indianapolis Hoosier Athletic Club , (1st listing of IRC being INC.) K9EUQ- Pat Husk? (see 1928 & 62 Hamfest pdf files).
1929-1932	W9JP operates portable at club outings (CW) Xmtr. <i>Then silent till 1935 !</i> Club remained at the Century building until 1932, W9JP operated here too! Membership increased and it sponsored Hamfest & Indiana State Park outings.
*1928	By now club is well know as Indianapolis Radio club.
1932-1935 *1930	Meet in Peoples State Bank Building . Outdoor activities reached a peak?! 1st Club Equipment auction Held ! where?
1935-1938	* Liberty Building * Wimmer Building * St.Paul's Episcopal Church * Insley Building, Olney & St Clair St.
**1938	fall W9JP back on the air, CW & Phone on 160-80-40 & 20 meters.
1939-1944	Cropsey Auditorium

- **1940** **W9JP was D.M. Davis (IRC ham station call used since 1926)....(1st trustee)**
1st Women's Program during IRC Hamfest/ convention (1940 HF pdf)
- 1943 **April, June & July - Warren Hotel (1st meeting local that the club rented .)**
And IPD headquarters at New York & Alabama.
- *1946** **Frame community-building, east 16th St.(Club met EVERY Friday night.)**
- 1947 **Jan.5th; moved to rooms above DRUG STORE at 25th & Station St.**
Feb.5th; Move to N.E. Community Center, W9JP back on for a short time.
- *1946** **Frame community-building, east 16th St.(Club met EVERY Friday night.)**
- *1950s** **Indianapolis. Park board-building, W. 30th St..**
- 1951 **May 4th; Servicemen's Center at 100 N. Capitol, W9JP more elaborate.**
- 1952 **October; Marine Armory at White river & 29th St.**
- *1953-64** **Indianapolis. Park board-building, W. 29th & Harding St..**
- **1960-** **IRC was incorporated (Possibly before this date) By K9EUQ?(IRC Treas.)**
- *1962** **May have been 1st IRC HOME BREW NITE & Antique Swap & Shop ?!**
- *1970-1994** **Christian Missionary Headquarters Bldg. in Irvington (2nd & 4th Fridays / Mo)**
(Longest in one meeting place!)
- 1994-present** **Indianapolis Training Center 2820 N. Meridian St. (old Stouffers Hotel) (2nd Friday /Mo)**
Sponsor is ITC
- 2004 **-First internet website www.IndayRadioClub.org sponsor ; Webnavigatic**
- 2004 **-First IRC Member BUS trip to the DAYTON Hamvention (38) participated.**
Became annual event.
- 2005 **-ITC-IRC restarted Ham youth programs and classes. First was in 1960's**
