Chapter -7 in HRLM covers some of this document.

Just be familiar with these documents and where to look up rules regarding Ham radio operations.

2- As of January 2007 No CW code test is required for the Technician License. (Tech & Tech plus will share the same privileges) For testing the frequencies are separate until the new question pool is received in mid 2007.
