### **Highlights from the April Meeting:**

Called to order at 7:30 pm via Zoom by club president, David Spoelstra, N9KT. There were 33 in attendance. In attendance was one new ham, Nat Rajagopalan, KD9WTU. Next David introduced Tim Duffy, K3LR, CEO of DX Engineering. Tim talked about new products available at DX Engineering. First was the line noise detecting loop antenna designed by Don Kirk, WD8DSB. Tim showed several RG-214 cables they can custom manufacture. He had lots of lightning protection gear. Tim said DXE has recently purchased Hi-Z Antennas products. ## **IT'S ALMOST TIME FOR THE INDIANA QSO PARTY!**

It's almost time for Indiana to be "rare DX", and everyone to be looking for us! The Indiana QSO Party, or INQP for short, will be held on Saturday, May 6, from 11:00 am to 11:00 pm local time, or 1500 UTC Saturday through 0300 UTC Sunday. All stations may operate the full 12-hour period. The full rules for the event can be found at <http://www.hdxcc.org/inqp/rules.html>. As always, there will be a club competition, so if you work the INQP and turn in a log, please specify the Indianapolis Radio Club as your club. If no one from Ft. Wayne submits a log, we might win ;-)

There are several other QSO parties occurring this same weekend, so the bands will be very busy, AND FUN! Also, with band conditions looking pretty good, contacts should be plentiful. So, get on the air on the following bands: 160, 80, 40, 20, 15, and 10 meters in either SSB or CW modes and call CQ! If you are a Technician class operator, remember you can operate on the 10 meter band between 28.300 and 28.500 SSB, or on CW in portions of the 80, 40, and 15 meter bands.

So, get on the air on May 6! Even if you only log a handful of contacts, submit your log. Most of all, HAVE FUN!
