PHILMONT SCOUT RANCH RADIO ACTIVITIES

Three Indianapolis Radio Club members recently spent around 2 weeks in the scenic mountains of northeast New Mexico demonstrating amateur radio to around 200 Scouts and adult leaders. Jim Brown, WORLD, David Spoelstra, N9KT, and Ken Bandy, KJ9B were set up daily on the porch of the "Tooth of Time Traders". Jim served as host, giving an overview of what was going on to those that paused. David was mainly demonstrating satellite radio, and Ken had a VHF/UHF station set up as well as an HF station making primarily FT8 contacts. The three stayed on site at the Scout Ranch, each in a 10' x 12' semi-permanent tent, and dined with the Scouts and leaders in the dining halls of the facility. The local wildlife, primarily deer, were obviously used to having people around, as they were often observed munching on crab apples from the plentiful trees on site regardless of human activity in the area.

Signals from the Past:

From the June, 1964 Amachewer:

In keeping with the "progress" of the state of the art of amateur radio, the following excerpts from a bulletin to all Army MARS members is very interesting:

"... an extensive study (by Dept. of the Army) ... concluded that the requirement for a sound and undiminished CW capability ... will continue indefinitely and that pertinent doctrine, training and equipment must be kept compatible with this requirement ... CW continues to be used in a multitude of tactical radio nets where a high degree of reliability is required ... (It) is used extensively ... as a standby or backup for RTTY and voice during periods of ... interference, and atmospheric disturbances. The use of CW ... has increased (in) importance of this capability since it is frequently the only effective means of communication due to system or equipment incompatibility, language barriers and frequency congestion."

In other words, CW continues to be the **BASIC** method of radio communications.
